Dear Parents/Guardians:

We have the opportunity for students in grades 9-10 to participate in summer school at LPA. In order to plan and prepare, it is necessary to send out this letter regarding summer school, prior to the end of 4th quarter. Summer school will be held **June 4th– 22nd, from 8 a.m.–12 p.m.** in the high school Media Center. Students will have a short break daily built into the schedule. However, they will not be allowed to leave campus. Therefore, they are responsible for bringing their own snack and something to drink if they choose.

The focus for summer school will be for credit recovery. Your child qualifies for summer school because they have or will receive an F in a class or are behind in credits. Please note your child's transcript is attached. This is an opportunity for students who have received an F to make up the credit to be on track to graduate with their class.

Summer programming will utilize the online Acellus curriculum with a licensed instructor. Students are **required** to attend every day. Students who are not attending daily or not completing daily coursework will not receive credit.

Please complete the form below and return it to the high school in care of, Don Donarski, by May 22nd, if you choose to have your student participate. We understand that the school year is not yet complete, but we need to secure the appropriate staff for this summer.
