

Technology Equipment Agreement

The following document is an agreement made in good faith between the student and the Lake Park Audubon School District (School). By signing this agreement the student and Parents/Guardians have read and understand this document, the Computer Contract, the Lake Park Audubon Internet Acceptable Use Policy and all that they entail.

The term "equipment" will refer to any computer, network, peripherals, printers, software and any accessories and licenses associated with the above items.

Each student is assigned one (1) laptop, one (1) AC power adapter, and one (1) Backpack or Protective Case.

It is the student's responsibility to take care of this equipment and protect it from damage at all times. Any problems should be reported immediately to the Technology Coordinator.

The School holds the right to recuperate any cost of repair of any damage incidental or accidental if it has been deemed to an act of neglect or abuse.

No student should try to alter, circumvent, modify, or attempt any activity that could place the equipment in danger or change the designed use and behavior of the equipment.

This equipment is considered School property being lent to the student for the purpose of educational instruction. Any other use of equipment may be monitored, restricted, or removed per the discretion of the School at anytime. If excessive violations occur by the student the School may take action to restrict access to equipment for a determinant amount of time.

The School district has implemented a new Web Filtering policy that complies to the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) just as the previous Web Filter has done. The new filter has a take-home policy that enables Parents/Guardians to have the ability to allow or limit the accessibility of various categories or specific websites their child may have access to outside of School grounds. The School has implemented a default CIPA take-home policy that can be adjusted by the Parent/Guardian as they feel fits within their own acceptable use standards. It is recommended by the School that Students and Parents/Guardians engage in conversation as to what level of internet accessibility and to continue to have this conversation throughout the year.
