LPA High School Happenings

The **end of the first quarter** of school is quickly approaching – November 2nd. Report cards will be available for parents to pick up in the office when you come for **Parent Teacher Conferences** on November 13th or 15th from 4:00 – 7:45 p.m.

Students in grades 7-10 will participate in **Bus Safety Evacuation and Drill** on October 24th as part of an annual requirement.

Other drills that are required for the year include 5 **fire drills** and 5 **lockdown drills**. Students have participated in one fire drill and one lockdown drill so far this year. Lockdown drills will begin to incorporate **ALICE Training** components. Eight district employees, including myself attended ALICE Training this summer and are certified ALICE instructors. All staff received training on ALICE during the district August workshop day. During the open house, we held a parent meeting to present ALICE Training to parents. The next step is to work with students on the components of ALICE training (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate). The training with students will take place during Raider Rally time throughout the school year. Our first step will be to explain ALICE Training to students and then add the components of ALICE to lockdown drills.

PBIS – ask your student what it means (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) is supported by all LPA Staff. Students who are display the high school components that support PBIS are recognized by receiving LPA (Leadership, Pride and Achievement) Recognition. This may be in the form of a paper completed by a teacher where the student brings the recognition to my and receives an award from the treasure box, or is recognized by the weekly LPA Recognition nominated by a department and is announced on the PA and their picture is posted on the website and in the paper.

If you do not have access to ParentVue, please contact Sherri Lefebvre to secure a password. This allows you to check on your students grades at any time.

The first **Choir Concert** of the year is scheduled for Thursday, November 1st at 7:30 p.m. A wonderful performance is in store for everyone.

The fall musical, A Little Princess, is also quickly approaching. Students in grades 7-12 will be able to attend an afternoon matinee on November 9th for only \$1.00.
