# ALICE

This year, like many schools across our nation, Lake Park Audubon has implemented new security measures in our buildings. Some of these changes will be visible with secure entries being installed soon. Other measures are intended to empower our staff and students by giving them additional tools, options, and training. The model we choose for student and staff training is ALICE:

A – Alert (Notify others in building, call 911)

L – Lockdown+ (Lock, barricade, spread out, know exits)

I – Inform (Plain language, update, anyone can notify)

C – Counter (Distract with noise and objects)

E – Evacuate (Rally points, zigzag, never leave safe situation)

### Trainings

October: Drill to introduce lockdown+ & inform

November: Evacuation drill with students

December: Discussion with students about counter & alert
